

8th Grade Dance – Friday May 7, 2010

This is the **official permission slip and payment request** for the 8th grade dance. It is also the **request for a baby photo** of your student (non-returnable, no larger than 5x7, clearly identified on back, can be a copy).

Note: No student can attend the dance without a permission slip signed by parent or guardian on file.

Return permission slip, **payment of \$25/student** (checks made payable to CMS PTA), and baby photo to CMS Office. Mark your envelope 8th grade dance! ***We will gladly accept any additional financial donations to help with the many costs of the dance, thank you for your support!***

Dance Attire

(strictly enforced – students will be turned away from dance if do not adhere to attire)

Girls: No backless, no revealing necklines, no long dresses. Must have a wrap or jacket (that cannot be removed) if strapless or spaghetti straps are worn.

Boys: No shorts, no sandals, no t-shirts, no tuxes. Polo-style collar or dress shirt with slacks. Jacket and tie optional.

Dance Rules

1. The dance starts at 7 pm and ends promptly at 10 pm. Students must be picked up by a parent NO LATER than 10 pm.
2. Only current 8th grade CMS students, with signed permission slips, are allowed to attend.
3. Students must attend school and stay all day on May 7th. No early check-outs except for doctor or dentist appointments. If checkout for these reasons, student must present doctor's note at the dance.
4. Any student who is assigned an in-school or out-of-school suspension on May 7 will not attend the dance.
5. Students must check in immediately with teacher/administrator at front of building before entering. In the interest of safety, each student will be "swept" with a detector wand, by school administrator, to make sure no one has an object which is inappropriate.
6. Any student who comes to the dance after 7:30 pm must have a parent check them in through an administrator.
7. Students MUST stay in designated areas. These areas include the gym, cafeteria, the hall between the two, and the 700 hall between the restroom and the gym.
8. Students can be accompanied to the front of the building by a teacher or administrator for a legitimate reason.
9. Students will be dismissed through the front of the building. No student will be allowed to walk home. Parents must pick up students in front of CMS. NO EXCEPTIONS.
10. No student is allowed to leave the dance early unless a parent comes into the building and checks a student out through an administrator.
11. All Fulton County and School rules will be in effect. Violations of rules may result in disciplinary action and involvement of law enforcement.
